

BYLAW 1-2007

A BYLAW OF STRATHCONA COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING BYLAW 38-98 AND ADOPTING THE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, a Municipal Development Plan has been prepared for Strathcona County based on public input and studies of land use, development, services and such other relevant data; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Municipal Development Plan describes the way in which the future development of the County may be carried out in an orderly and economic manner;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Strathcona County, duly assembled, and pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Development Plan Bylaw of Strathcona County".
2. That Schedule "A" attached hereto, the document entitled "Strathcona County Municipal Development Plan" containing goals, objectives, and policies, is hereby adopted as part of this bylaw.
3. This Bylaw hereby repeals the Strathcona County Municipal Development Plan Bylaw 38-98 and all amendments thereto.
4. This Bylaw comes into effect after third reading and upon being signed.
