

**BYLAW 100-2001**

**A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT CASINOS IN STRATHCONA COUNTY**

WHEREAS Part 1 of the Municipal Government Act, S.A. 1994, Chapter M-26.1, as amended, provides that the purpose of a municipality, *inter alia*, is to develop and maintain safe and viable communities;

AND WHEREAS Part 2, Division 1 of the Municipal Government Act, S.A. 1994, Chapter M-26.1, as amended, gives Council the jurisdiction to pass bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;

AND WHEREAS Council has received a valid and sufficient petition from electors of Strathcona County for a bylaw prohibiting gambling casinos within Strathcona County;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Strathcona County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

**1. TITLE**

1.1 This bylaw shall be known as the "Casino Bylaw".

**2. DEFINITIONS**

2.1 In this Bylaw:

2.1.1 "Casino" means an establishment that provides facilities for patrons to participate in gaming opportunities as its principal purpose but does not include a Casino that occurs on an infrequent basis that is incidental to another type of establishment, and does not include a bingo;

2.1.2 "Council" means the Council of Strathcona County.

**3. APPLICATION**

3.1 That Casinos are prohibited in Strathcona County.

**4. EFFECTIVE DATE**


4.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect when it receives third reading and is duly signed.
