

BYLAW 47-2008

A BYLAW OF STRATHCONA COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND CONSERVATION EASEMENTS BYLAW.

WHEREAS the Council of Strathcona County has passed Bylaw 68-2005 to regulate the Unauthorized Use of Environmental and Conservation easements; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend Bylaw 68-2005;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Strathcona County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

That Bylaw 68-2005 be amended as follows:

1. That Section 2.1 Definitions be amended by replacing the words "Special Constable" with "Peace Officer".
2. That Section 3.8 of the bylaw be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Prohibition, Inspection and Order

- 3.8 A Person who receives a written Order under this part may request a review of the Order by written notice within fourteen (14) days of the day on which the Order is received. The request for review must be accompanied by the required fee as set out in the Fees and Charges Bylaw, as amended and replaced from time to time. Upon reviewing the Order, the Bylaw Enforcement Order Review Committee may confirm, vary, substitute or cancel the Order.
3. This bylaw comes into effect after third reading and upon being signed.


READ a first time this 7 day of October, 2008.

READ a second time this 7 day of October, 2008.

READ a third and finally passed this 7 day of October, 2008.
