

## BYLAW 11-2012

### A BYLAW OF STRATHCONA COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE DOG CONTROL BYLAW 85-2006.

WHEREAS, THE Council of Strathcona County has passed Bylaw 85-2006 to provide for the licensing, confinement and control of dogs within the said County:

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to amend Bylaw 85-2006 in order to allow for a yearly license fee.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Strathcona County, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 85-2006 be amended by adding a new section following Section 3.2.5 as follows:


3.2.6: Licences issued under this Bylaw shall be valid from April 1 to March 31 in any calendar year.

This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third reading and upon being signed.
