## Riverside Nature Trail

Township Road 540. One trailhead at Twp Rd. 540 and Range Road 232. Other trail head is west on Twp Rd. 540, about 1 km

This 5.5 km riverside nature trail runs along the North Saskatchewan River.

## Warning: Unknown Ice Conditions!

The onset of winter means colder temperatures and the start of ice forming on ponds and streams. People of all ages are tempted to venture onto the new ice. However, early snowfall insulates the thin layer of ice and doesn't allow it to freeze properly. Freeze/thaw cycles make the ice unstable.

All ice, at any time of year, can be dangerous. Obey all posted signs! On-ice safety is a personal responsibility.

The stormwater ponds in Sherwood Park are part of our stormwater management system and are not meant for skating. Stay off the stormwater ponds.
