4. Artisans or their approved designates must remain at their booth during the hours of operation.
5. Artisans shall ensure that they have legal title to the works and that the works do not contravene the provisions of THE COPYRIGHT ACT, THE TRADEMARK ACT, or any provisions of THE CRIMINAL CODE OF CANADA.
6. Strathcona County reserves the right to refuse any applicant.

Booth:

- There is no cost to participating in Art on the Patio; however artists are responsible for providing their own display equipment including tables, and/or tents, dollies, etc.
- There is no access to electricity for this event.
- This is an outdoor event. In the case of inclement weather, the event will be moved inside Festival Place.
- Gallery@501 staff will contact you to confirm when your application has been accepted, and which dates you have been scheduled for. Applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Set up will occur from 6:00-7:00 p.m. on the northwest corner of Festival Place, to the left of the concert stage. Take down will be after the concert between 9:30-10:00 p.m.
- Early set up/take down will not be accommodated. The Qualico Patio Series concerts begin at 7:30 p.m.
- All set up and removal is the responsibility of the Artist/Artisan. Strathcona County staff are not available for assistance in moving artwork or displays.
