Further to our previous letters, Strathcona County has engaged CIMA+ to conduct a Functional Planning Study for Highway 15 between Range Road 220 and Highway 830 North. A Functional Planning Study, which is required by Alberta Transportation, determines the "medium- and long-term needs" of the highway. It also studies what effects these "needs" may have on the surrounding landowners and community.

This is why we are contacting you! You and your neighbours are invited to an open house to learn more about the Functional Planning Study.

This is the second of three open houses for the project. At this open house information will be provided regarding future interchange improvements along the Highway 15 corridor - including conceptual interchange layouts and potential impacts to properties adjacent to the highway. Your feedback at this stage is crucial to the success of the project.

The third open house will be held in mid-September. More information will be provided via mail outs and newspaper advertisements over the course of the summer about this final open house.
