Township Road 522 Upgrade Public Information Open House

Please be advised that Strathcona County will be hosting a Public Information Open House for the Township Road 522 Upgrade from Highway 21 to Highway 824 (Range Road 222).

Drop in at a Public Information Open House on:

Thursday, October 15, 2015 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Strathcona Olympiette Centre (Fultonvale) 2nd Floor, Preschool Room 52029 Range Road 224 Strathcona County

Residents are invited to learn about the next phase of upgrades to Township Road 522. Information boards will be on display focusing on design and construction from Highway 21 to Range Road 224, and preliminary planning from Range Road 224 to east of Highway 824 (Range Road 222).

Strathcona County staff will be in attendance to answer questions you may have about the project. McElhanney Consulting Services and DEMA Land Services will also be available to provide detailed information to adjacent landowners and kick off discussions on adjacent property requirements for the section from Highway 21 to Range Road 224.

The current road is narrow, has no shoulders and has steep slide slopes. These characteristics make it difficult for vehicles to pass each other, and the steep side slopes add collision severity risk for vehicles leaving the roadway. The roadway improvements will provide a safer roadway, including wider lanes, paved shoulders, better sight lines, and gentle side slopes.
