

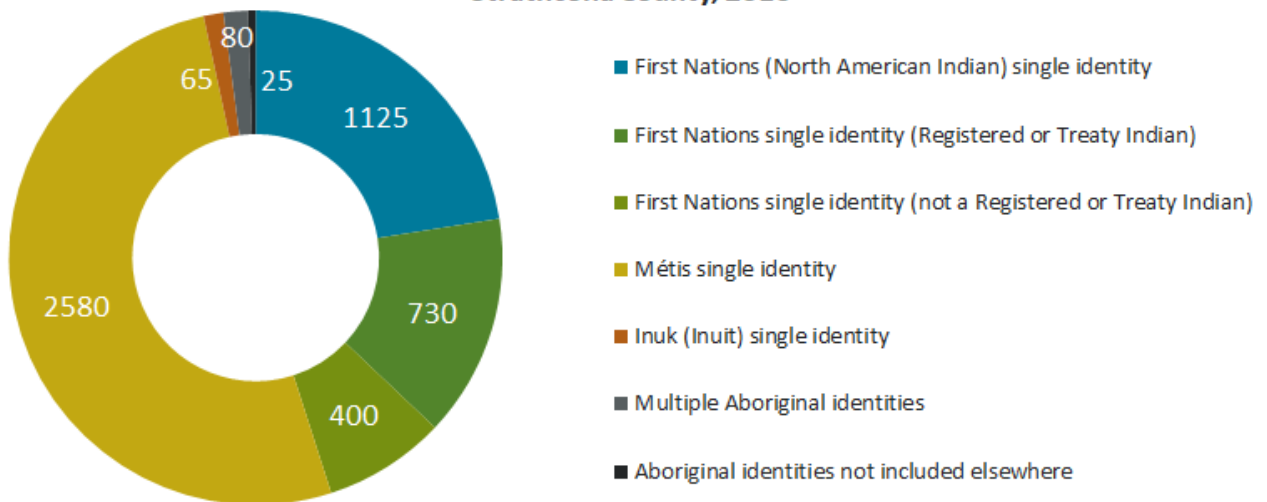

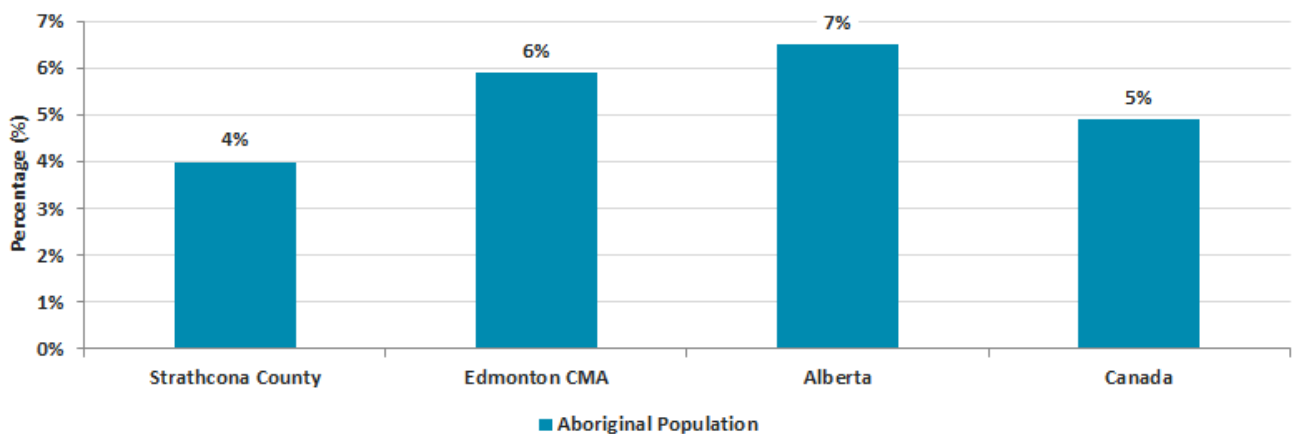
Aboriginal Population

- The large majority of Strathcona County's Aboriginal population identifies as Metis of single identity and First Nations (North American Indian) of single identity.
- A total of 4% of the population of Strathcona County is Aboriginal. This proportion is lower than the Edmonton CMA, Alberta, and Canada (6%, 7%, and 5% respectively).

Age Distribution by Aboriginal Identity

- Roughly 29% of Strathcona County’s Aboriginal population is between the age of 0 to 14 years old. This is slightly higher than the Edmonton CMA and Canada, and is comparable to Alberta.
- The second age category with the highest proportion of Aboriginal people in Strathcona County is 15 to 24 years old (16%), slightly lower than the Edmonton CMA, Alberta, and Canada.
- Strathcona County has a slightly higher proportion of its Aboriginal population above the age of 35 relative to the comparator geographies.
