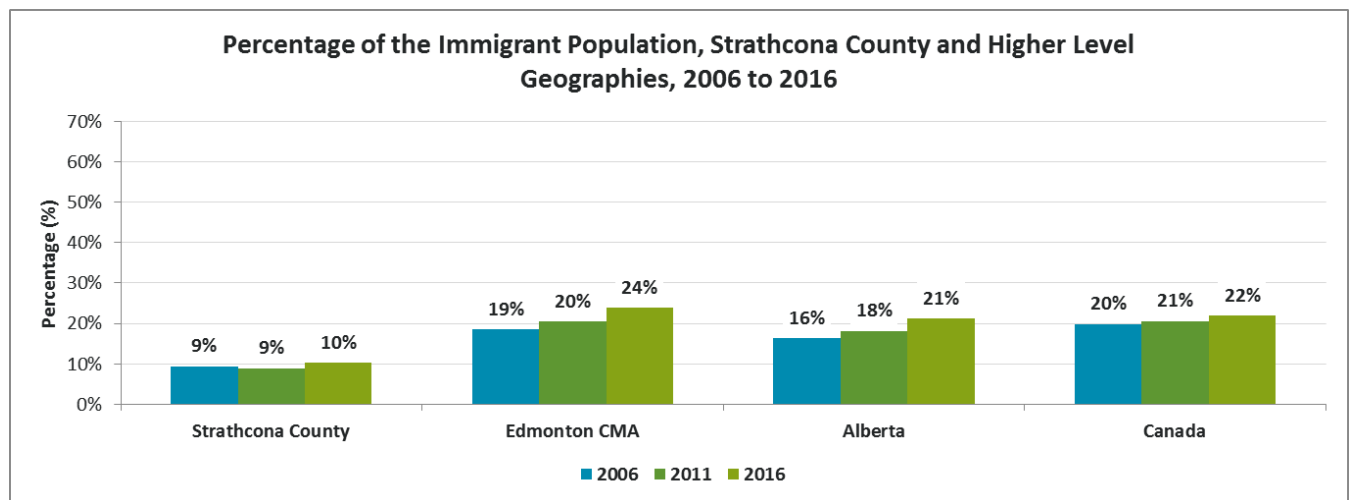


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Immigration and Ethnocultural Diversity

Immigrant Population

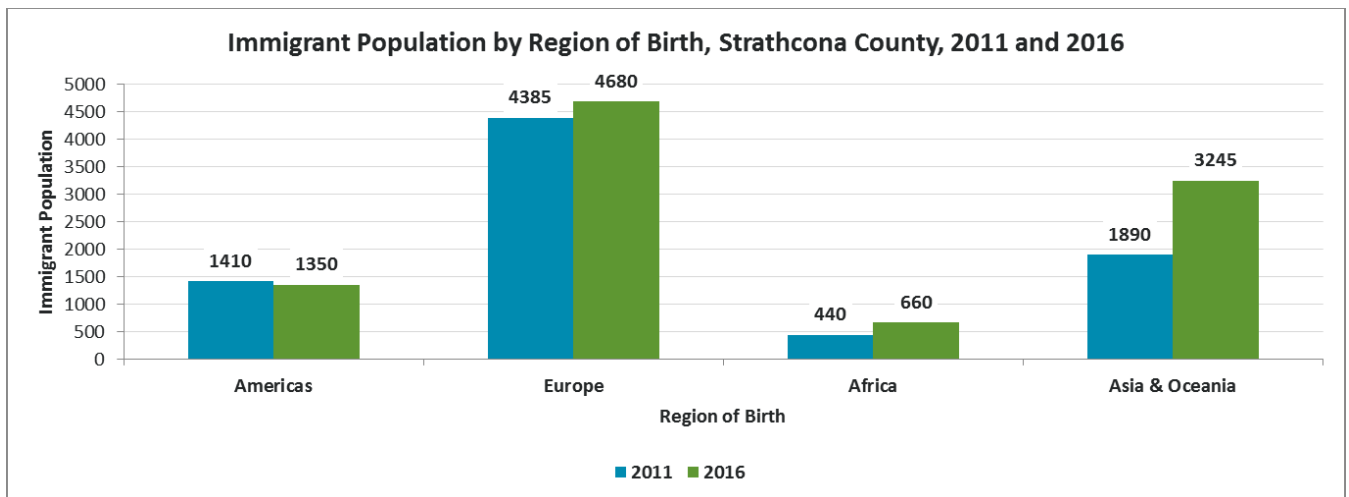
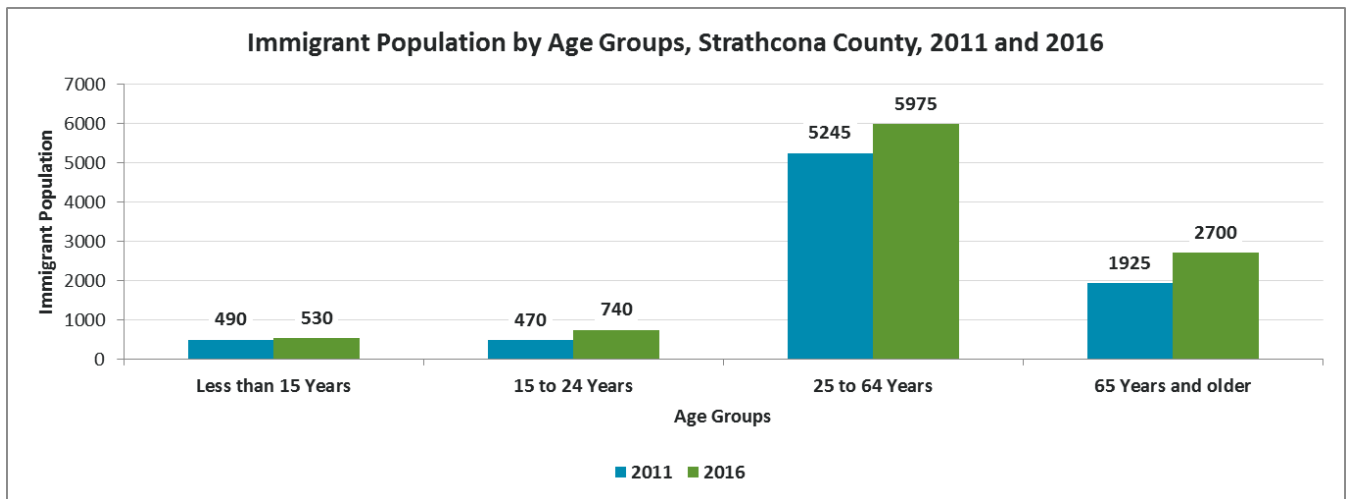
- The percentage of the immigrant population increased in Strathcona County from 2011 to 2016. It also increased in the Edmonton CMA, Alberta, and Canada.
- The immigrant population in Strathcona County saw increases from 2011 to 2016 in all age groups, with the largest increase in the 65 years and older age group as well as the 25-64 years old age group.
- Strathcona County saw an increase in immigration from a variety of regions of birth during the 2011-2016 periods, the largest of which was from Asia & Oceania. There was a slight decrease in the immigration of people from the Americas.



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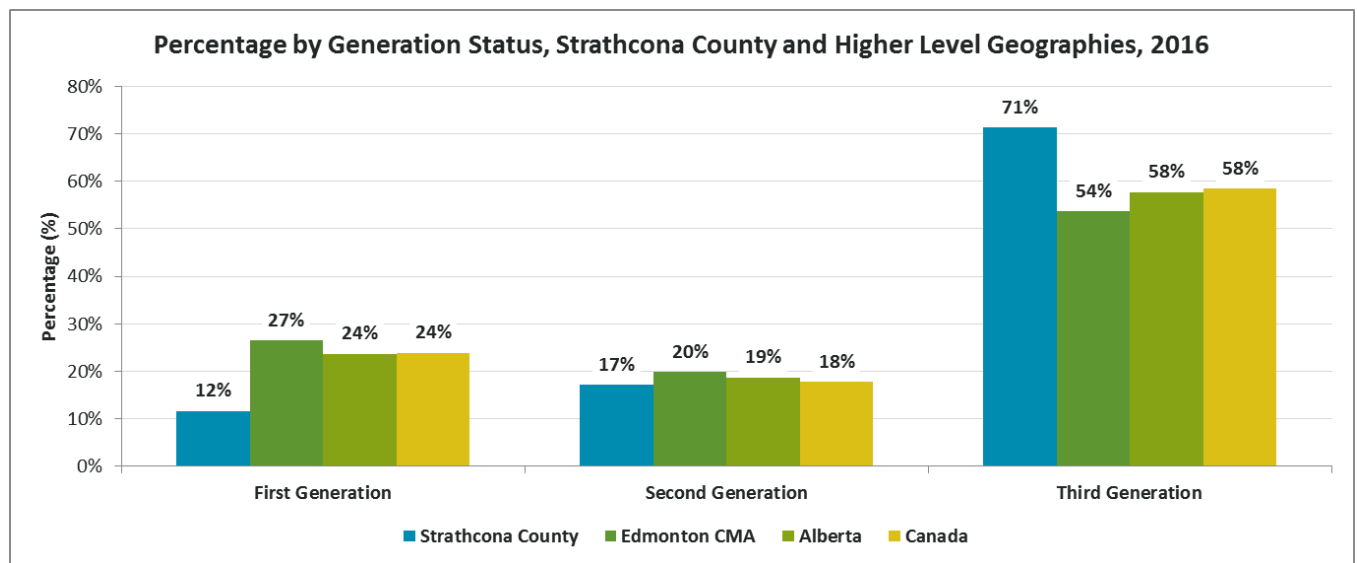


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Immigration and Ethnocultural Diversity

Generation Status

- Strathcona County has 71% of its immigrant population as third generation, with 12% and 17% being first and second generation respectively.
- When compared to the Edmonton CMA, Alberta, and Canada, Strathcona County has a significantly lower first generation immigration percentage and a significantly higher third generation immigration proportion.

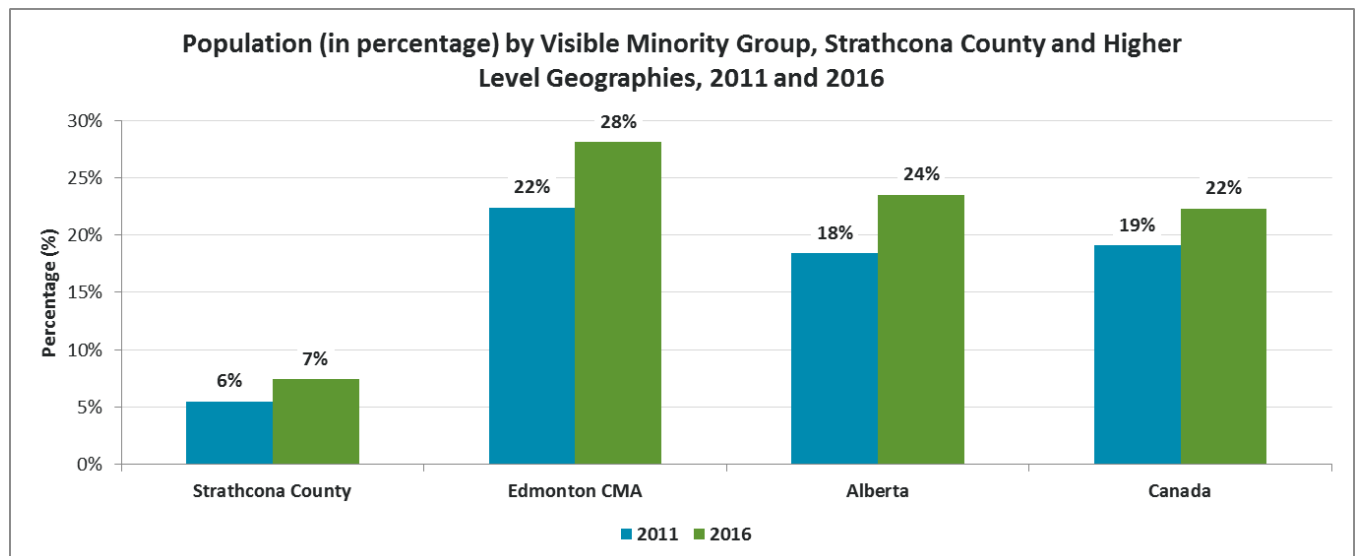


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Immigration and Ethnocultural Diversity

Visible Minority Population

- Strathcona County saw a 1% increase in the percentage of visible minorities from 2011 to 2016. This increase in visible minorities was smaller than increases in the Edmonton CMA, Alberta, and Canada (6%, 6%, and 3% respectively).

Ethnic and Cultural Origins of the Population

- Strathcona County's population largely originates from European origins (82%). This is much higher than each of the Edmonton CMA, Alberta, and Canada.
