

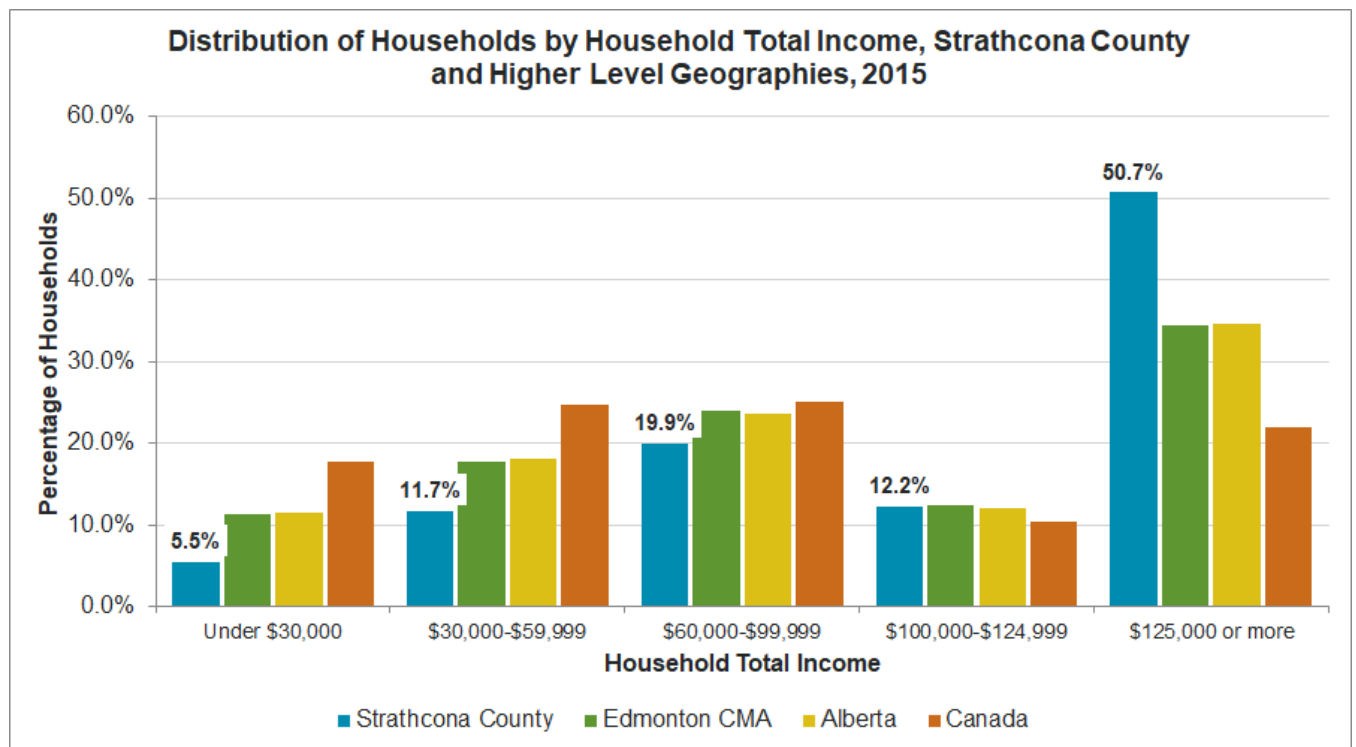

Median Income of Households

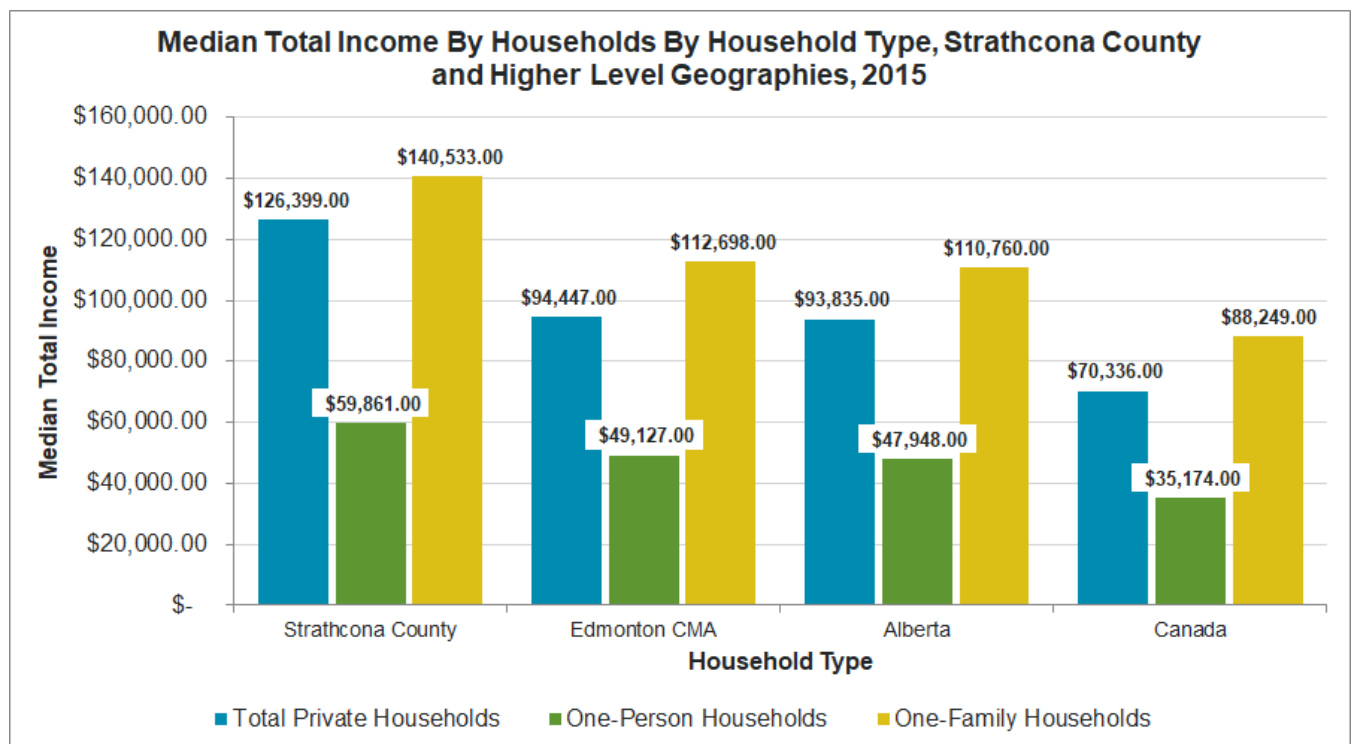
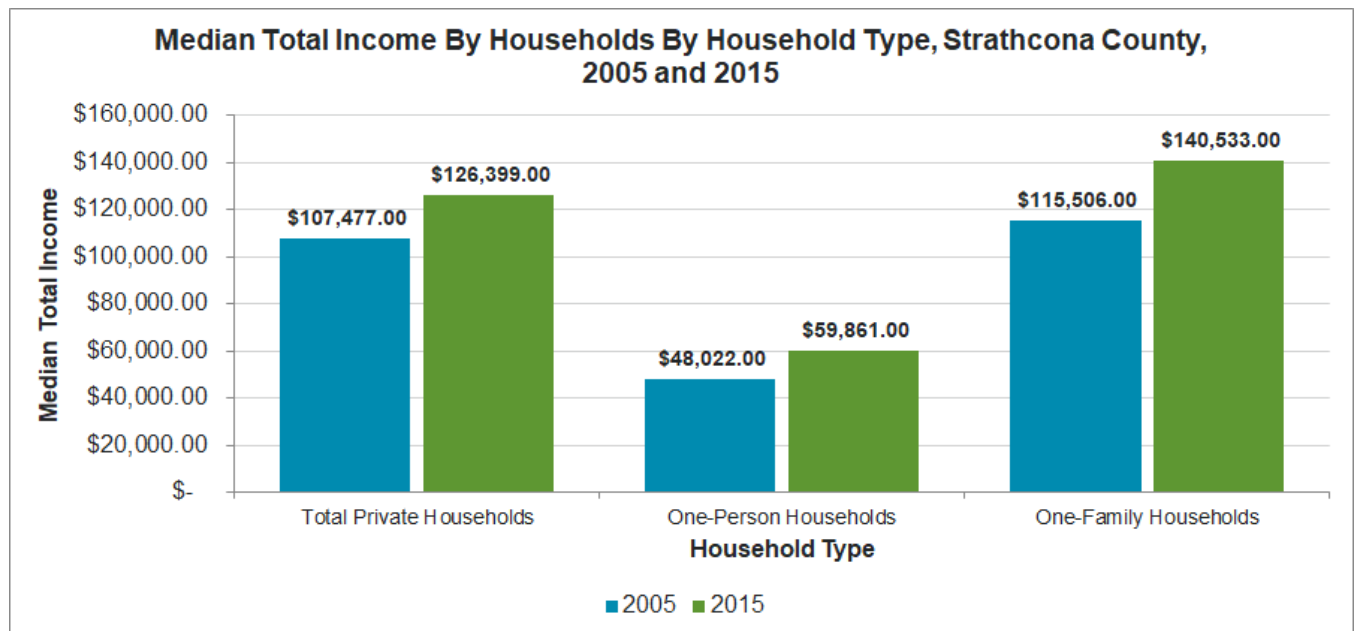
Quick Facts

- In 2015, the median total income of households in Strathcona County was \$126,399, a change of 17.6% from \$107,477 in 2005.
- In 2015, 50.7% of the total households in Strathcona County had an income of \$125,000 or higher.
- In 2015, the median total income of households in Strathcona County was higher than the Edmonton CMA, the province, and the nation totals.

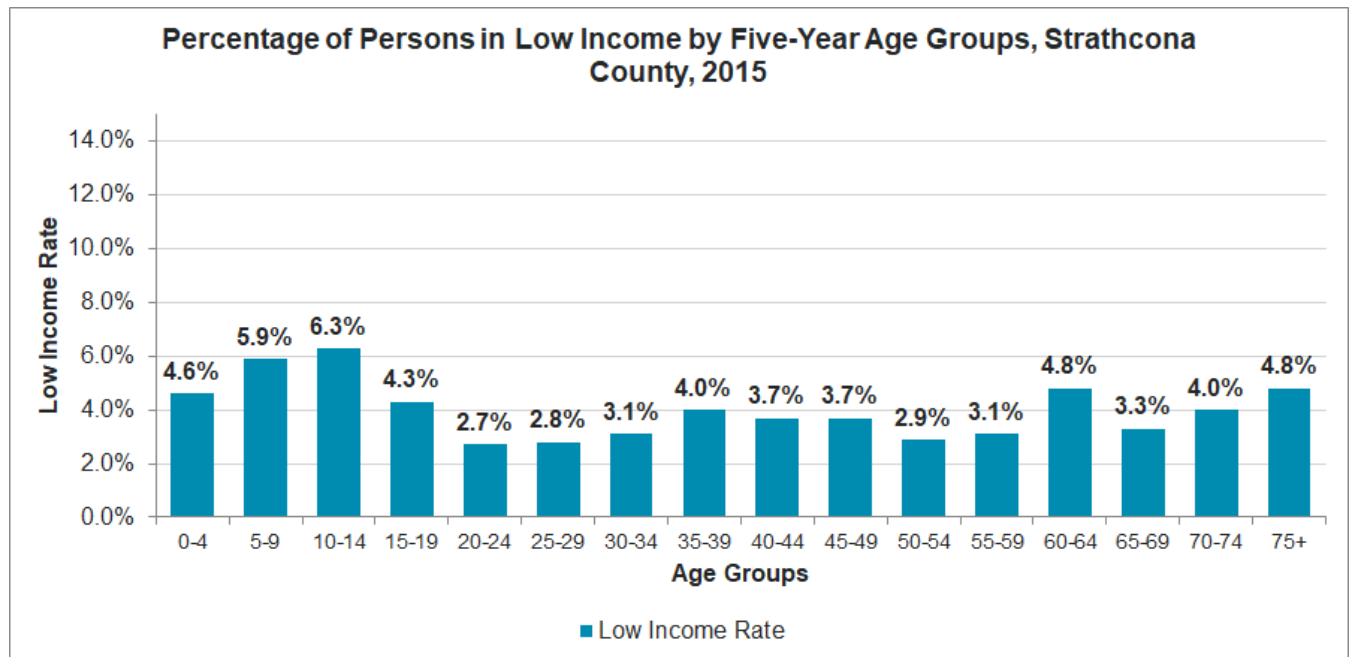

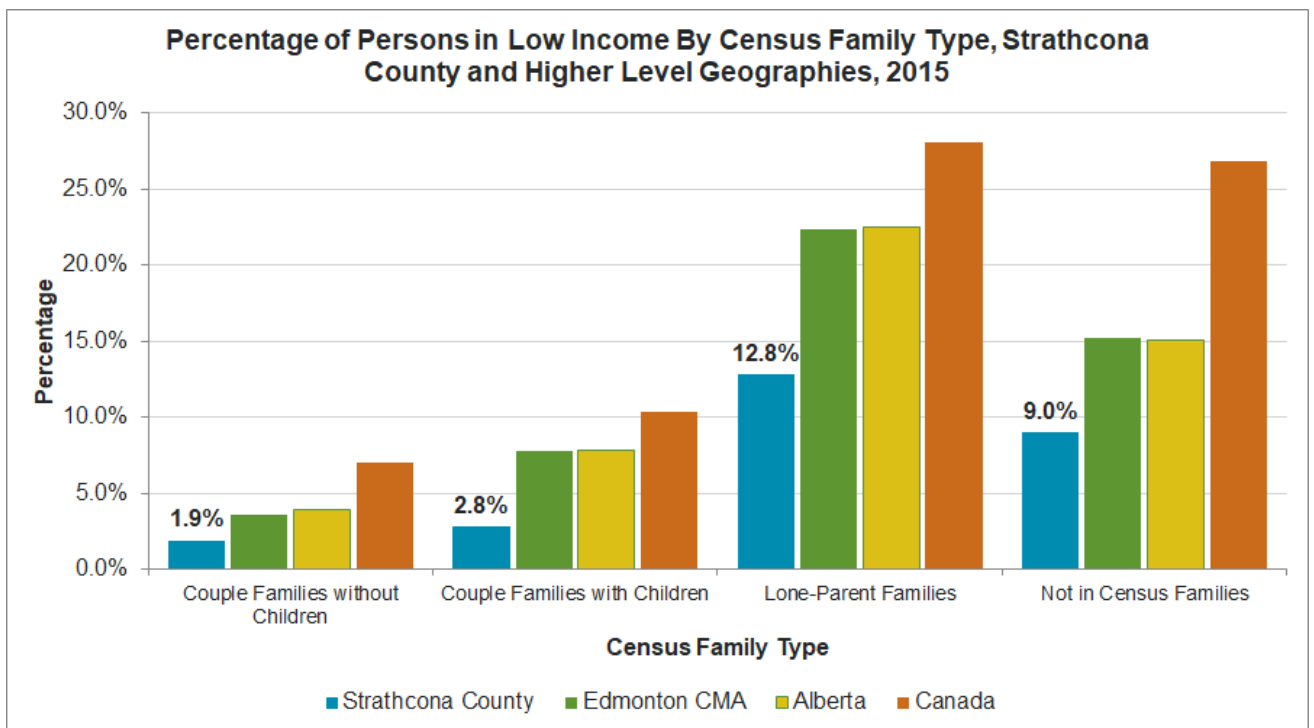
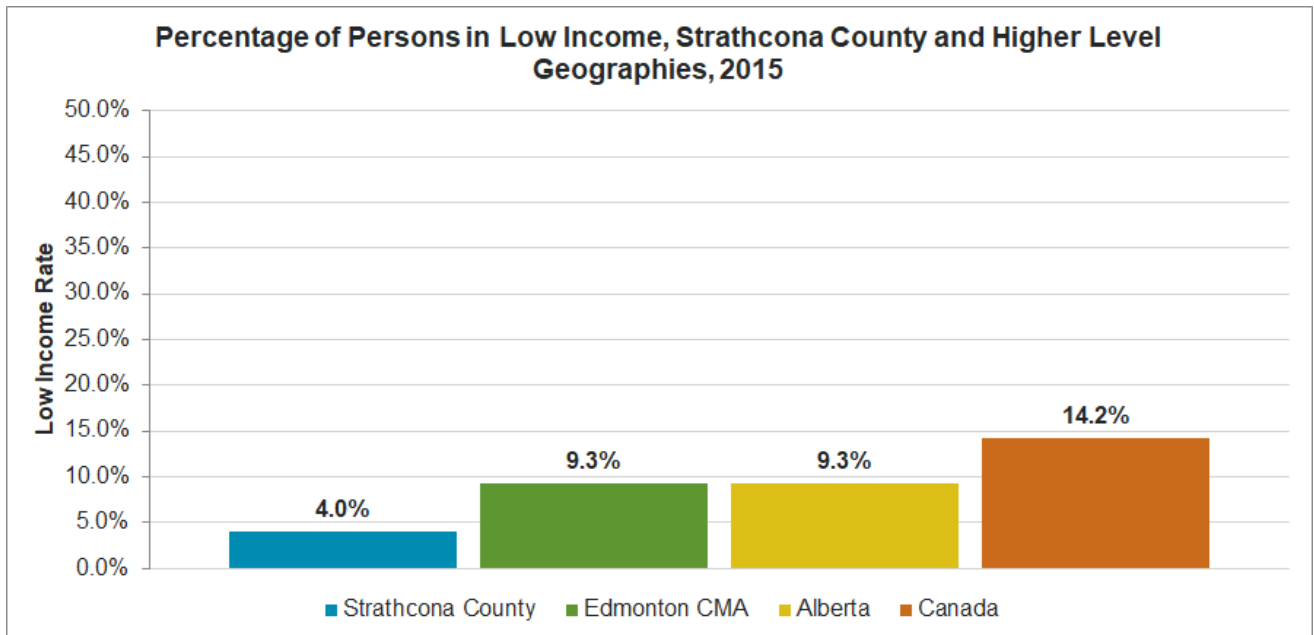
Low Income

- In 2015, 3,895 persons or 4.0% were in low income.
- Persons living in lone-parent families had a higher rate of low income at 12.8%, while those living in couple families without children had a lower rate of 1.9%.

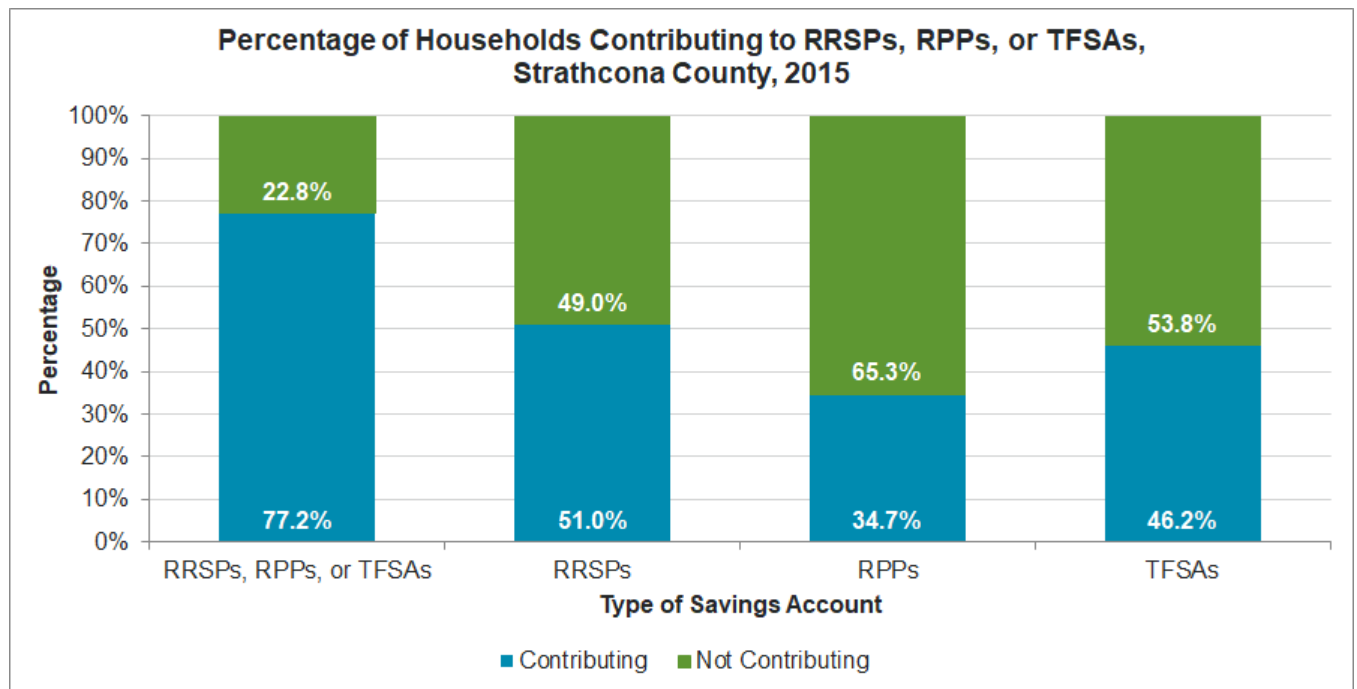

Income

Savings

- In 2015, 77.2% of households in Strathcona County contributed to Registered Retirement Savings Plans (RRSPs), Registered Pension Plans (RPPs), or Tax-free Savings Accounts (TFSA). In Alberta, 68.4% of households contributed to an account while 65.2% of households contributed nationally.

Income

Income of Couples

- In 28.4% of couples in Strathcona County, each partner had fairly equal incomes in 2015 while men had higher income in 59.8% of couples and women had higher income in the remaining 11.8% of couples.
- For Canada overall, each partner had fairly equal incomes in 32.0% of couples with men having the higher income in 50.7% of couples and women having higher income in 17.3% of couples.
- In 2015, the median total income of couples in Strathcona County was \$138,273 compared to \$87,688 for all couples in Canada.
- The median income of higher-income partners in 2015 was \$95,490 and the median income of lower-income partners was \$37,020.
