6.2	 Tourism Strategy & Implementation Plan and next steps Council recently approved the Tourism Strategy and now we are working on where we go from here and how to capitalize further. This is a community owned strategy and will take a lot of stakeholders including the Chamber of Commerce and other business associations, etc. to make it successful. Administration is involved in budget at the moment, and high-level business cases including tourism are an area of focus.
