Agora

A large, multi-purpose space, the Agora is a great meeting place for celebrations, events and conferences.

Two spacious outdoor plazas adjacent to the Community Centre provide a great setting to host an outdoor event. Many of the indoor meeting spaces access directly onto the plazas.

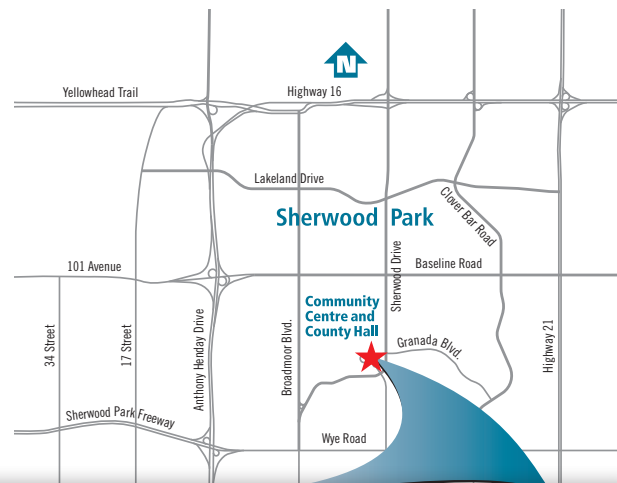
Transit
