

STRATHCONA COUNTY COMMUNITY BACKGROUNDER

Our shared goal is to create a supported, safe and connected community in Strathcona County.

Set in the centre of Alberta's energy and agricultural heartland, Strathcona County is a vibrant specialized municipality that offers almost **96,000 residents** a perfect blend of urban and rural living. Strathcona County is made up of over

1,200 square kilometers that include hamlets, acreages, urban neighbourhoods and rural and industrial lands. We are a welcoming place to live and attract people of all ages, cultures and walks of life to come join us.

- 1 in 7 is a senior and this segment of the population will continue to grow.
- 1 in 11 are immigrants and this number is growing.

COMMUNITY

- **86%** of residents gave Strathcona County high/very high ratings as a safe community in which to live.
- **95%** of residents would recommend Strathcona County to others as a good place to live.
- Over **4200 hours** of community volunteer service in the past year.
- Over **1,250,000** annual admissions to recreation facilities in the past year.
- 14 Community Halls & 4 Seniors Centres

EDUCATION

• High school completion rates and university education levels are among the highest in Alberta.

INCOME

• Residents experience some of the highest income in the province.

EMPLOYMENT

- Employment rate is 72.3% compared to 67.3 % for Alberta.
- **Unemployment is 5.3%** compared to 7.8% for Alberta.

COMMUNITY

• Knowing 6 or more neighbours by name has been decreasing.

EDUCATION

- Younger students are more likely to feel they live in a caring community. This feeling decreases as students move into high school.
- **40%** of Junior High and High school students said they were bullied.

INCOME

- 1 in 20 residents live on less than \$40,000/yr.
- Some single family homes live on less than \$20,000/yr.
- 1 in 3 seniors live on less than \$40,000/yr.

HOUSING

- Average cost of a home is among the highest in the region.
- 1 in 7 is spending more than 30% of income on housing alone.

STRATHCONA FOOD BANK USAGE

• Foodbank usage has doubled in 2016.

MENTAL HEALTH

• **Significant increase in doctor referrals** for depression, anxiety and stress in 2016 compared to 2015.

ADDICTIONS

• **Increase in the number of referrals** to addictions services and more opiate use than seen in previous years.

FAMILY VIOLENCE

• Reported number of **domestic violence cases increased by 18%** in 2015.
