| Purpose        | 1 The purpose of this bylaw is to amend Bylaw 17-2020 to provide an in-person option for certain presentations to Council and Priorities Committee, including Public Hearings.  |
| Amendments     | 2 Bylaw 17-2020 is amended as follows:<br><br>(a) The word "will" is deleted and replaced with the word "may" in Section 2(a);<br><br>(b) Section 2(b) is deleted and replaced with:<br><br>(b) Persons interested in making a submission as part of the Public Hearing may contact the Director's office to provide a written submission by email; and may either:<br><br>i. Register to make a presentation at the Public Hearing by electronic means; or<br>ii. Register to make a presentation at the Public Hearing in person.<br><br>(c) Section 2(c) is deleted;<br><br>(d) The words "or in person" are added following the words "electronic means" in Section 2(i); and<br><br>(e) The word "must" is deleted and replaced with the word "may" in Sections 3 and 4. |
| Effective Date | 3 This bylaw comes into effect on the earlier of either the date it is passed and signed or August 1, 2020.   |
