## **Policy Statement**

Strathcona County's aquatic facilities are intended to generate opportunities for the benefit of residents that enable the pursuit of healthy lifestyle choices.

Recreation, Parks and Culture shall have in place a policy to offer an equitable system of distribution of pool space to the various pool users within Strathcona County.

The pool allocation policy covers the following users:

- Special Events
- 2. Recreational Swimming
- 3. Recreation, Parks and Culture Aquatic Programs
- 4. Rental by registered non-profit Youth Pool User Groups
- 5. Rental by registered non-profit Adult Pool User Groups
- School bookings (pursuant to the guidelines in the Reciprocal Use Agreements)
- 7. Private Rentals

The order of priority for allocation will follow the seven categories of pool users identified above. The distribution of hours to user groups in County pools will be determined using a cooperative approach based on input from identified user groups. Group representatives will serve on the Youth Pool User Group Committee, whose purpose is to meet annually to determine an agreeable allocation of available pool hours for their users; and to identify and address issues relating to their shared use of pool space.
