

BYLAW 82-2004

A BYLAW OF STRATHCONA COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE SAFETY CODES BYLAW.

WHEREAS the Council of Strathcona County has passed Bylaw 44-2003 to administer the Building, Electrical, Plumbing, and Gas disciplines of the Alberta Safety Codes Act, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend Bylaw 44-2003 in order to establish requirements for Low-Flow Plumbing Fixtures;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Strathcona County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 44-2003 be amended as follows:

1.1 Section 2: General – Definitions be amended by adding the following new section after 2.2.6:

2.2.6(a) "Low-Flow Plumbing Fixture" means, as applicable, a CSA certified water closet with a rated flush capacity of not more than 6 litres per flush, or a CSA certified showerhead with a flow capacity of not more than 9.5 litres per minute.

1.2 Section 7: Permit Administration be amended by adding the following new section:

7.13 Low-Flow Plumbing Fixtures shall be required for all water closet and showerhead installations pursuant to all plumbing permits issued after December 31, 2004.
