

WASTE ROADMAP GIFT CARD DRAW CONTEST RULES FOR 18-24 YEARS OLD

WASTE ROADMAP GIFT CARD DRAW (“Contest”)

This Contest is open to Alberta Residents Only, and is Governed by applicable Canadian and Alberta Law

CONTEST PERIOD:

Contest Name (“the Contest”) begins on OCTOBER 29 at 12:00:01am Mountain Time and ends on NOVEMBER 5 at 11:59:59pm MT (“The Contest Period”)

CONTEST ELIGIBILITY:

Contest is open to all legal residents of Canada residing in Alberta OR Strathcona County who are between the ages of 18 and 24, except for children of employees, contractors, representatives or agents of Strathcona County (and those with whom such persons are domiciled, whether related or not), and their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside). By participating in this Contest, you agree to be legally bound by the terms and conditions of these Official Rules and Regulations (the “Rules”).

HOW TO ENTER (CHOOSE ALL THAT ARE APPLICABLE)

Online Entry Form – The participant may obtain one entry into the Contest by completing the online survey at SCOOP.strathcona.ca. Fully complete the entry form provided at the end of the survey and agree to the terms and conditions of these Official Rules and Regulations.

All eligible Entries received during the Contest Period will be entered into the random prize draw.

PRIZE(S) AND APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUE:

1. One of two gift cards for Sherwood Park Mall; Prize Name; Approximate Retail Value \$50 each

RANDOM PRIZE DRAW AND WINNER SELECTION:

On NOVEMBER 5, 2020 (the “Draw Date”) in Sherwood Park, Alberta at approximately 11:00am MT, two eligible entrant will be selected for the Prize by random draw from among all eligible Entries received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period.

Strathcona County or its designated representative will make five (5) attempts to contact the selected entrant by telephone or email (using the information provided at

the time of entry) within ten (10) business days of the Draw Date. If the selected entrant cannot be contacted within five (5) attempts or ten (10) business days of the Draw Date (whichever occurs first), or there is a return of any notification as undeliverable; then that selected entrant will be disqualified and Strathcona County reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to randomly select an alternate eligible entrant from among the remaining eligible Entries.

Prize will only be awarded to the person whose full name and valid email address appear on an official Contest entry form.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

All Entries become the property of Strathcona County.

All Entries that are incomplete, illegible, damaged, irregular, have been submitted through illicit means or do not conform to or satisfy the conditions set forth in these Contest Rules, may be disqualified by Strathcona County. This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws. The decisions of Strathcona County with respect to all aspects of this Contest are final and binding on all entrants without right of appeal, including, without limitation, any decisions regarding the eligibility/disqualification of Entries and/or entrants.

By entering this Contest, each entrant expressly consents to Strathcona County, its agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing and using the personal information submitted with his/her Entry for the purpose of administering the Contest and in accordance with Strathcona County's privacy policy.
