Green Organics Cart



Place these items in your green organics cart:

Food waste (e.g. vegetable and fruit scraps, meat bones, egg shells, coffee grounds)
 Yard waste (e.g. grass clippings, plant trimmings, leaves)
 Soiled paper (e.g. tissues, paper towel, paper napkins, toilet paper)
 Pizza boxes
 Shredded paper (in a compostable bag or loose but buried in cart)
 Pet waste (in a compostable bag, loose or in a cardboard box)



Blue Bag



Place these items in your blue bag. They must be clean and free of foods, liquids and dirt:

- 1 Hard plastic containers, tubs and bottles. No lids or caps. (e.g. detergent, condiment or shampoo bottles; margarine and large yogurt containers; ice cream pails)
- 2 Aluminum and tin cans, pie plates and containers (clean and in
- **3** Wrapping paper (no foil), greeting cards (decorations removed)
- Office paper, envelopes, craft paper
- 5 Magazines, flyers, newspaper, catalogues
- **6** Books with front and back covers removed
- **Boxboard** (e.g. cereal, cracker, cookie)
- 8 Cardboard, flattened (60 cm by 1m or smaller)



Black Waste Cart



Place these items in your black waste cart:

- Plastic bags, wrap and plastic packaging from toys, food and household items (e.g. grocery bags, food wrap, resealable bags, fruit and vegetable bags, cereal box liners, plant pots)
- **2** Plastic clamshells (e.g. berries, salad, bakery items)
- 3 Single-serve plastic cups (e.g. yogurt, pudding),
 Single use plastic items (e.g. cutlery, straws, coffee pods),
 To-go cups (e.g. coffee and drink cups, lids, and straws)
- Plastic toys and other plastic household items
- **5** Small Styrofoam (e.g. meat tray, take-out containers)
- 6 Foil wrappers and bags (e.g. granola, candy bags, chip bags)
- **7** Disposable diapers and wipes
- 8 Hygiene products (e.g. toothpaste tubes, toothbrushes, Q-tips)

- **1 Propane tanks** (e.g. barbecue)
- 2 Household hazardous chemicals (e.g. cleaners, disinfectants and
- 3 Paint, stain and the containers
- 4 Used oil, antifreeze and the containers
- **5** Electronics (e.g. TVs, computers, monitors, printers, stereos,
- 6 Appliances (e.g. fridges, stoves, dishwashers, washers)
- **7** Light bulbs (e.g. halogen, CFL and fluorescent tubes)
- **8** Batteries (household and car)
