Instructions to Presiding Deputy (PD)

- 1. Before a person is recognized as a scrutineer, they shall make, in front of the presiding deputy at the voting station, a statement in the prescribed form (Statement of Scrutineer).
- 2. The presiding deputy shall not permit a candidate to have more than one scrutineer present at any time in the voting station during voting hours.
- 3. The presiding deputy shall not permit a candidate to have a scrutineer present while the candidate is present in a voting station during voting hours.
- 4. The presiding deputy shall not permit a candidate to have both an official agent and a scrutineer present at the same time in a voting station during voting hours.
- 5. The presiding deputy may designate the place or places at a voting station where a candidate or a scrutineer of the candidate, may observe the election procedure.
