<b>Traffic</b>	
Statements related to speed limits, traffic lights, and lanes	
Speed limit changes at Salisbury	
No limits—but want turning lanes	
Turning lane from Wye Road to 232	
Turning lanes are desperately needed	
Like to see more speed enforcement	
Reduce speed to 50 km	
RR 231/232—move local traffic	
Don't like traffic lights/traffic circles	
Signaling, timing issues	
Need to be smart timing	
No need for double lane	

<b>Accessibility</b>	
Statements related to the range roads offering accessibility outside of Estate Drive	
Access point for new development at NW corner	
Don't restrict access for Estate Drive	
Are S/W required if urban intersects?	
Feeling of more space (road intersects)	
Use 232 instead of Wye Road to get to Anthony Henday Drive—or get home	
Offset intersection w/ cemetery

Statements around noise, lighting	
Noise concerns w/ lights	
Sound proof fence along boulevard	
Focus on noise, traffic, and residential	
Noise is key issue (accelerating, decelerating) #1 issue	
Noise at traffic circle is problematic	
Pollution #2 issue	
Like peace and quiet	
No lights is a good thing	
Option to drop road to enhance noise attenuation?	
Light pollution → from light poles
