## Did You Know?

### What is an Area Redevelopment Plan?

An area redevelopment plan provides guidance to landowners who decide to redevelop their properties in the future, should they choose to do so. The area redevelopment plan will generally outline acceptable uses, forms and densities of development in different areas and the infrastructure required to facilitate such development.

### Why do we need to update the existing plan?

The existing Centre in the Park Area Redevelopment Plan was originally completed in 1990 and has since been amended on several occasions. The document is outdated and requires replacement.
