Did You Know?

What is Density?

Density refers to the number of people living within a specific land area.

The 2017 Edmonton Metropolitan Region Growth Plan sets mandatory density targets for urban centres, like Centre in the Park.

What is Diversity?

Diversity refers to a mix of development such as residential, commercial, institutional, and recreational land uses.

What is Design?

Design refers to an attractive, cohesive, and distinct built environment that reinforces compact development, pedestrian-oriented design, and walkability. Design considers the relationship between buildings, streets, and open spaces.
