

## Leaf rubbing

Discover patterns, textures and shapes of leaves in the school yard or forest.

### Supplies:

- Leaves
- White construction paper or card stock
- Crayons, pencil or charcoal
- Flat surface (clipboard or sidewalk)

### Instructions:

1. Place the leaf of choice under your piece of paper on a flat surface.
2. Using the side of a pencil or crayon gently rub over paper with the leaf under it until the pattern appears.
3. Try using different leaves and colours.
4. Remember to respect nature and use leaves from the ground.

Try creating a large tree mural out of the classes bark and leaf rubbings.
