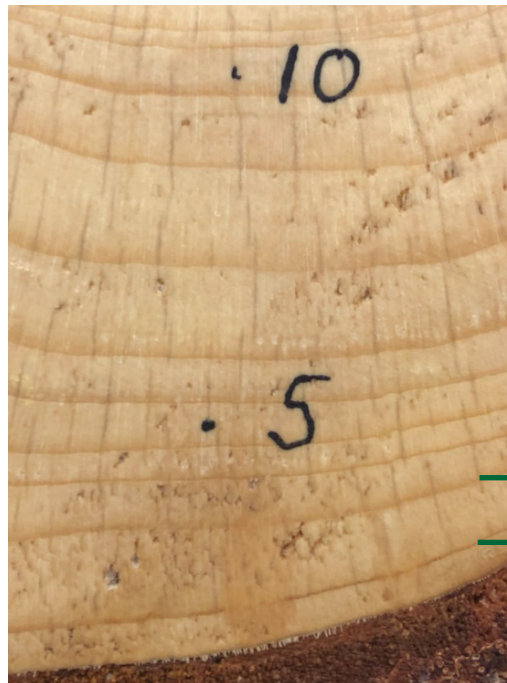


How to count tree growth

These pictures provide an example of how to count the years a tree has been alive. Every ring equals 1 year of life.



One year includes a light and dark portion. It is easiest to count either the light or dark rings, but not both.
