## Explore by Trails

Strathcona County has hundreds of kilometers of trails to help residents explore their community. Visit [strathcona.ca/trails](http://strathcona.ca/trails) to view all of the trails. There are three types of trails that provide different experiences:

**Multi-use Trails** are asphalt, which are accessible year-round and are cleared of snow in the winter.

**Nature Trails** are granular, grass, dirt, or wood mulch. These trails can be found adjacent to most Sherwood Park wetlands as well as at the Strathcona Wilderness Centre, Sherwood Park Natural Area, Deermound and Sally Stewart Dog Off-leash Parks, and the Beaver Hills Biodiversity Trail. Snow is not removed from these trails in the winter.

**Riverside Nature Trail** is a 5.5 km trail that runs along the North Saskatchewan River and was constructed in partnership with the River Valley Alliance. The Trailheads are located at Twp Rd 540 and Rge Rd 232 as well as 1km west on Twp Rd 540.

**Strathcona Wilderness Centre** offers scenic trails year-round for hiking, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. Equipment rentals are offered in-season: disc golf, cross-country skis, sit-skis and snowshoes. Pets, including dogs and horses, are not permitted. **Sherwood Park Natural Area** is a 3 km trail loop, located on Rge Rd 231, between Twp Rd 520 and 522. Dogs are permitted, on-leash. [strathcona.ca/naturalarea](http://strathcona.ca/naturalarea)

**Deermound and Sally Stewart Off-Leash Parks**  
The Deermound Off-leash Park is located 3 km south of Wye Road on Highway 21. Turn west onto Twp Rd 522 (Hwy 628). Sally Stewart Off-leash Park is located in Sherwood Park off Buckingham Dr.

**Beaver Hills Biodiversity Trail** is a 2.5 km natural trail surface located at Rge Rd 211 and Twp Rd 530 (Baseline Road), on the east side of the Strathcona Wilderness Centre. Dogs are permitted, on-leash. [strathcona.ca/bhi](http://strathcona.ca/bhi)

**Regional Trails** are also known as the Trans Canada Trail and the River Valley Alliance Trail. This trail connects Strathcona County to the City of Edmonton and the City of Fort Saskatchewan. Please see map below for details.

## Accessibility

There are over 270 km of accessible asphalt surfaced trails throughout Sherwood Park that provide the best opportunity for those with mobility challenges.

- Please note the following trails are considered more challenging (exceeding a 5% slope):**
- Nottingham subdivision, section of trail extension
  - Section behind Recreation Administration Office North side of Broadmoor Lake (followed by sharp corner)
  - Ball Lake south bridge - (followed by sharp corner)
  - Heritage Hills - north of Highland Drive (many sections are steep)
  - Trail section west of Courtenay Drive along Craigavon Drive
  - Granville Park - walkway north of Granville Crescent
  - Extension south of Sioux Road towards Woodlake Road
  - Trail section west of Ottewell House
  - Broadmoor North Lake west access off Oak Street
  - Millennium Place parking lot to the soccer fields

## Share the Trails

- Respect the rights of others
- Stay to the right – except when passing
- No off-highway vehicle use permitted
- Cyclists: Yield to pedestrians, and use a bell or your voice when passing  
Be seen – wear bright or reflective clothing and have a light and reflectors

## Dogs in Our Parks

Dogs, on-leash, are allowed in most parks. Dogs can be off-leash at the designated off-leash sites. All requirements of the Responsible Dog Ownership Bylaw must be met. Please clean up after your dog.

- Are there places my dog can't go?**
- Playgrounds (sand or grass beneath playground equipment)
  - Tennis courts, spray parks and floral gardens
  - Strathcona Wilderness Centre

## Bike and Skate Parks

**Strathcona County Bike Skills Park**  
300 Broadview Road, Sherwood Park

Hours: 6 a.m. - 11 p.m. (unsupervised park)  
This park offers a variety of natural features including dirt ramps, rock boulders and logs. Together, these features create a variety of ladder bridges, a wall ride and various sized dirt jumps to appeal to all ages and skill levels.

### Millennium Skate Park

2000 Premier Way, Sherwood Park (Millennium Place southeast parking lot)  
Hours: 6 a.m. - 11 p.m. (unsupervised park)  
Located next to Millennium Place, this 1,300 square metre park features 20 different activities, concrete design, permanent ramps, jumps and rails.

### Ardrossan Skate Park

Located just east of Ardrossan Recreation Complex

### Heritage Hills Children's Pump Track

235 Heritage Drive, Sherwood Park  
Hours: 6 a.m. - 11 p.m. (unsupervised park)  
A series of smooth hills and valleys on an oval track providing riders with a course of adventure.

**Remember** these are unsupervised facilities. Any unauthorized jumps and features will be removed. Strathcona County is not responsible for injury to park users.

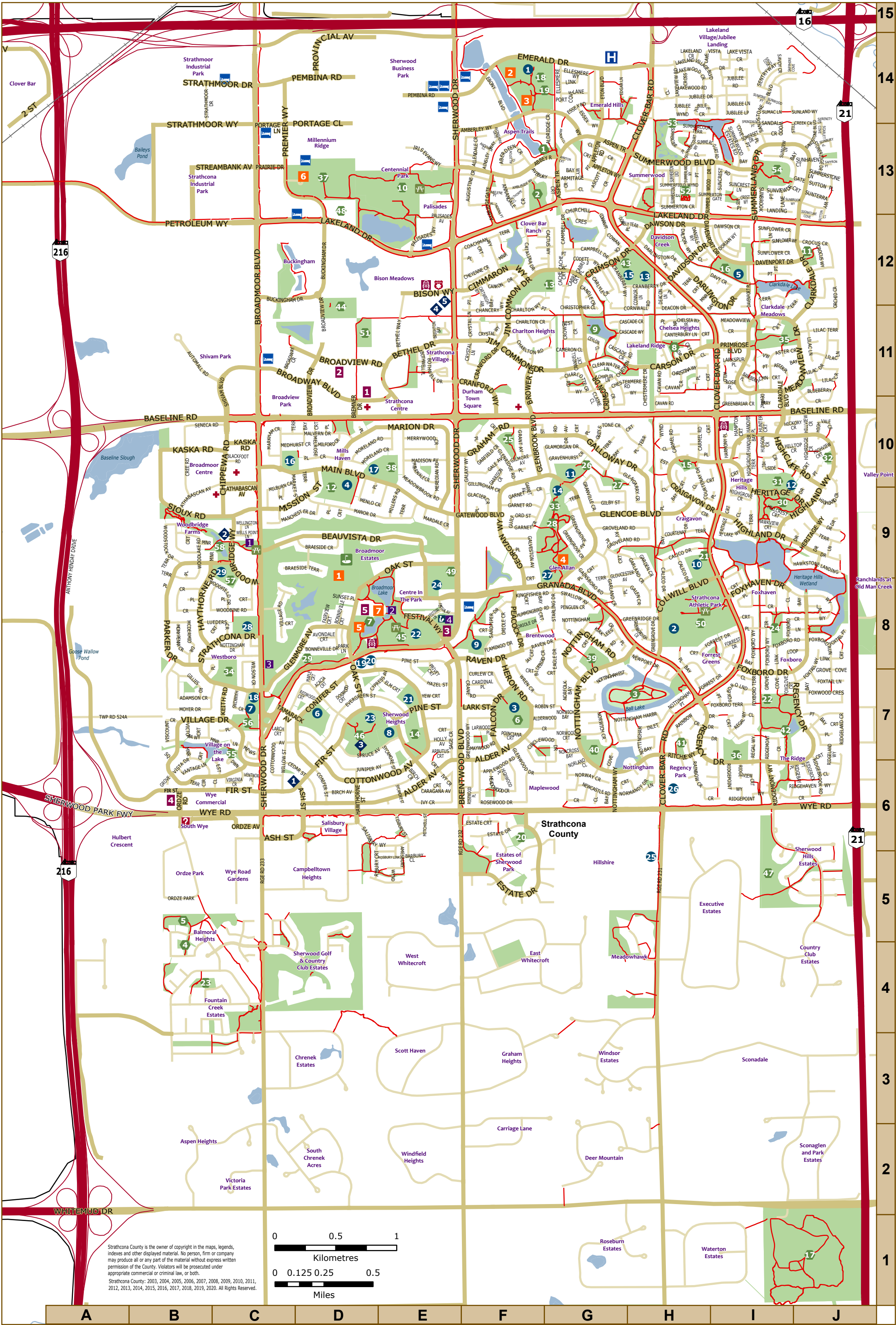
