Christmas Tree Safety checklist

Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when touched.

WRONG ! RIGHT

Place the tree away from heat sources. Make sure the tree is not blocking an exit.

RIGHT ✓



Use lights that are listed by a qualified testing laboratory. Pay attention to indoor/outdoor use.



Make sure the tree is at least 3 feet away from any heat source, like fireplaces, radiators, candles, heat vents or lights.

WRONG!





Check your decor for damage and replace as needed

Damaged decor lights may cause fire and electric shock!

> Don't overload your sockets! Do not use more than 3 light strands in a row
