



Consumer Fireworks Information

1. Consumer fireworks permits will not be issued in the following hamlets: Sherwood Park, Ardrossan, Josephburg, North and South Cooking Lake, Antler Lake, Hastings Lake, Half Moon Lake, Collingwood Cove.
2. Consumer fireworks permits will only be issued to individuals over 18 years of age. Applicants must be the legal landowner of the discharge site or have the landowner's written permission to apply.
3. Fireworks permit holders are required to call the Burn Status Line at 780-464-8464 or text the word 'BURN' to 587-340-3696 immediately before discharging to ensure that permits have not been suspended. Fireworks permits will be suspended if wind speeds exceed 15km/hour. Fireworks may not be discharged during a fire ban or fire restriction.
4. A consumer fireworks permit is valid for one event only. However, the date can be changed prior to the scheduled event by notifying Fire Prevention at 780-449-9651.
5. Neighbouring land owners whose properties or livestock may be affected by fireworks discharge must be notified, and permission obtained prior to discharge.
6. Fire fighting equipment must be in the immediate discharge area. Equipment can include fire extinguishers, pails of water, and garden tools.
7. Ground fireworks must be positioned out of the firing range of aerial fireworks and in a location where there is no dry grass or combustible materials on the ground beneath them. The area must be thoroughly wet down immediately before the fireworks are discharged.
8. Fireworks may not be discharged within 10 metres of any building, shelter or motor vehicle, or 200 metres of any place where explosives or flammable liquids are stored.
9. Fireworks may not be discharged from a highway, road allowance, public beach, over a body of water or park.
10. Fireworks are explosives. Ensure you read and follow the instructions, cautions and warnings on each firework. Fireworks permit holders must follow all terms and conditions outlined on the permit.
