



Participation in the Alberta North Central Regional Incident Management Team (NC RIMT) – Informed Consent

This form contains important information regarding voluntary participation in the Alberta North Central Regional Incident Management Team (NC RIMT).

What you can expect

An IMT is capable of providing a coordinated and sustainable response to any emergency situation and team members must be able and willing to provide expertise in a wide range of skills.

Block Training (3 sessions) will be provided at no cost to applicants. Once training is completed, you will be assigned to the NC RIMT as appropriate to your skills and incident needs.

Employees involved in training and/or providing assistance and expertise outside their regular hours of work or municipality may be eligible for pay and compensation as determined by their home municipality or applicable Collective Agreement.

What is expected of you

It is expected that you have obtained your Director of Emergency Management's (DEM's) approval to participate in the NC RIMT. You must be willing and able to commit to training and to providing your expertise within the region or the Province as requested (through an Emergency Operations Centre). It is also expected that you will maintain your IMT "Go-Kit" and have a certain degree of flexibility so as to be available upon short notice for deployment anywhere within the province. The length of deployment will be event-dependent but expected to be of no longer than a one-week duration.

Your rights

It is your right to revoke this consent at any time; however, doing so will result in your removal from the Alberta North Central Regional Incident Management Team (NC RIMT) Program. You may rejoin for subsequent deployments; however, a new Application and Consent would be required.
