

Range Road 213 widening Open House

Report prepared December 13, 2018

Working with Al-Terra Engineering, Strathcona County invited feedback from residents related to the planned widening of Range Road 213 between Township Road 524 and Highway 16. The work includes a reconstruction to an industry-standard 7.5 finished roadway width.

The project was planned to be a staged project that will occur over two years. Stage 1 (2018) will be from Township Road 524 to Township Road 530 and Stage 2 (2019) will be from Township Road 530 to Highway 16.

Open House overview

Strathcona County invited residents to an open house at Uncas School on March 22, 2018 to gather feedback to validate or improve the engineering design. The County targeted highly impacted residents living in the subdivisions adjacent to the area planned for reconstruction by directly mailing open house invitation letters to their homes, advertising in the Uncas School newsletter, and placing digital signs promoting the event along the affected roadway. The event information was also added to the County's website.

Ninety people attended the event and were given the opportunity to speak with project managers and fill out feedback forms about the project. Interested residents could also provide their email address to receive project updates while construction is underway. The email subscription option was also included on the project webpage: www.strathcona.ca/rr213. Fifty-nine people have signed up to receive email updates as of December 13, 2018.

Next steps

During the 2018 construction season, road improvements on Range Road 213 were completed between Township Road 524 to about 800 metres south of Township Road 530. Landscaping along the completed section of road will commence in spring 2019, followed by continued road widening towards Highway 16.
