

Winter Roads 101

A quick guide showing when roads will be plowed and how long Strathcona County has to complete the clearing process.



Sherwood Park

Priority 1- Major arterials & thoroughfares

Includes roads such as Baseline Road and Wye Road



Min. snow depth accumulation
2-5 cm

Priority 2 - Minor arterials & school drop zones

Includes roads such as Sherwood Drive & Clover Bar Road



Min. snow depth accumulation
5-7 cm

Drop zones within 72hrs after Priority 1 complete

Priority 3 - Collector roads (permanent snow routes)



Min. snow depth accumulation
15-21 cm

Priority 4 - Residential Roads

Snow removal is based on the measurement of snow pack



Min. snow depth accumulation
10 cm

(compacted snow)
7 cm after January 1

Priority 1- Major industrial roads

Priority 2 - Minor thoroughfares that service schools & recreation facilities
