- 4.2 Meadow Hawk speed limit

The Committee was provided an update on the community driven, proposed speed limit changes in the Meadow Hawk subdivision. Members of the committee were supportive of the change but suggested that a change in policy for rural subdivisions with curb and gutter and no sidewalks be considered so that there is better consistency in speed limits in the future.

The Committee was provided an update on the community driven, proposed speed limit changes in Half Moon Lake. This issue is likely to be discussed at an upcoming Council meeting. A straw vote indicated that the Committee felt a similar process that was undertaken in Meadow Hawk subdivision (survey) should be followed to ensure the majority of residents were in support of the change in speed limit.


